FINANCIAL DECLARATION

All students who are or will be on an F or J non-immigrant visas must submit appropriate financial documentation. In order to issue you a visa document to enter or remain in the United States, the University of Louisville must be assured that you will have sufficient funds available to you to meet all tuition and living expenses for the duration of your studies. Graduate applicants are eligible to apply to their major department for competitive teaching or research assistantships or other scholarship opportunities. Health insurance will be required of all admitted international students on non-immigrant visas.

SOURCES OF SUPPORT

The total amount of support must cover the cost of expenses for the first academic year as listed on page one and should be reported in U.S. Dollars.

1. Personal funds of the student:

Attach an original bank official's letter verifying that you or your family has the total necessary funds on deposit.

2. Family funds from abroad or private sponsor in U.S.:

Attach an original affidavit of support from the sponsor specifying the amount and duration of the support and validity for attendance at U of L. The affidavit of support is an I-134 form which can be obtained off of the immigration website at www.uscis.gov. Attach an original bank official's letter verifying that the first year's funds are currently on deposit with the sponsor and that the sponsor has sufficient funds to assume the cost of study abroad for the student in the amount indicated. **(The name and relationship of sponsor to student must be clear on the official letter. If the financial support is provided by a U.S. sponsor, they must be a U.S. Citizen or Legal Permanent Resident.)**

3. Government, Agency or Employer:

Attach an original letter from the sponsor stating the amount and duration of the scholarship and validity for attendance at the University of Louisville.

PLEASE NOTE: For students from countries whose government restricts the amount of money, which may be sent abroad for your education, please attach a letter or approval from the currency control authorities stating that you will be eligible for currency exchange if accepted.
